Fire Chief Carlos Estrada commented that a dispatched helicopter would be used to fly patients.

Mr. Schmidt informed that a premise class could be arranged if there were 15-30 participants. Use of the new APX series of radios would be part of the class. Mr. Schmidt is available to assist in the arrangement of any class.

Board Member Mr. Campos inquired about class information that could be distributed to the City. Per Mr. Schmidt, there is an electronic flyer. City of El Centro Fire has a mailing list which was utilized for distribution of the flyer. There is electronic sign-up for classes.
